

FLOR ALVIDREZ, CANDIDATE FOR DENVER CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 7, QUALIFIES FOR THE DENVER FAIR ELECTION FUND

FLOR IS THE FIRST CANDIDATE IN DISTRICT 7 TO QUALIFY

DENVER, CO - MONDAY, AUGUST 29TH – Flor Alvidrez, small business owner, community leader, and candidate for Denver City Council District 7, has qualified for the Denver Fair Election Fund with over 100 contributions eligible for the 9x match.

“I have been so humbled and overwhelmed by the support of our grassroots campaign, and am thrilled to be the first candidate in District 7 to qualify for the Fair Election Fund,” Flor said.



Flor is running for the District 7 seat, currently held by Council Member Jolon Clark who is not running for reelection.

Susan Barnes-Gelt, a former at-large City Council Member and business-community liaison to Mayor Federico Pena, is an early endorser of Flor’s campaign. “Flor has deep roots in Denver and in Athmar Park. Her authenticity, strong business experience and history of civic leadership make her an ideal candidate to represent District 7 and the entire city,” Barnes-Gelt said.
